Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to term 4. This is a crucial term for the graduating cohort as they intensify their preparation for the GCE 'O' and 'N' level examinations. It is also an important term for the Sec 1-3 students as they will be taking their end-of year examination. Hence, we would like to encourage all parents/guardians to supervise your child's/ward's school work and revision at home. The end-of- year written examination will take place from 4 Oct to 14 Oct 2021. Students have already received their timetable and a copy of it and the topics to be covered for each level/stream can be found on https://ganengsengsch.moe.edu.sg/school-information/exammatters/.

While academic performance is important, it is paramount that you look into the mental well-being of your child/ward. Do connect with the Form and Subject teachers should you have any concerns about the learning and well-being of your child/ward. If need be, you may also request through the form teacher to talk to our Senior School Counsellor, Mr Sim. CCAs will stand down from 18 September to 15 October 2021 for students to focus their time and energy on academic work.

The Sec 1 to 3 students received their Personal Learning Devices (PLDs) on 1 September 2021 and we hope these PLDs will bring about greater engagement and deeper learning in them. Students are required to bring their fully charged PLDs to school every school day. The school has put in place routines to instil responsible and safe use of these devices. We would like to thank all parents/guardians who gave us feedback on the routines as your feedback helped us to refine our guidelines. We have also connected the PLDs with online platforms like SLS, iCON and Google Classroom that can be used for learning and revision. Do partner the school in monitoring your child's/ward's screen time and online activities.

In terms 1-3, the school had Home-Based Learning (HBL) for students on Wednesdays of even weeks. In term 4, HBL will cease and there will be curriculum redistribution for students to have more face to face interaction with their Form and Subject teachers. Do take note of the following changes:

Study Break For Sec 4Exp/5NA

The school will implement a study break from 11 Oct to 15 Oct for 4Exp/5NA students to give them time to focus on their revision. During the study break, students are strongly encouraged to remain at home unless they are involved in Science Practical papers, Listening Comprehension exam or consultations with teachers. We strongly urge you to ensure your child/ward stays home as much as possible during this period of time to minimize the possible exposure to Covid-19. All students who have contracted the virus, or who are placed on Quarantine Order (QO) will not be allowed to sit for any paper in the national examinations. Those placed on a Leave of Absence (LoA) or Approved Absence (AA), and those with MC will have to fulfil specific conditions involving ART and/or PCR swab tests before they are allowed to take the written papers.

Do take note that similar to last year, we will have a virtual Open House this year on 20 Nov 2021 (Saturday). Though there will be no face to face interaction with students, parents and the public, there will be live video sessions with school leaders and staff. More details will be provided by mid-Oct 2021.
