#### 2. Key Changes For Semester 2

i) Reporting Time For Students

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ii) Attire For Semester 2

With the rise in temperature and heat in the classrooms, school has reviewed its school attire policy. From Semester 2, students are allowed to be in half uniform as stipulated below:

- Mondays: Students must be in full uniform and in tie for morning assembly. They can change into their half uniform after morning assembly.
- Tuesdays to Thursdays: Students can come to school in half uniform. Half uniform is defined as PE T-shirt, skirt/pants. No other school-based t-shirt is allowed. Alternatively, students may come in full uniform if they do not have PE T-shirt for that day.
- Fridays: Dress down days. Students may wear their class-based or cohort t-shirts.
- Home-Based Learning (HBL) iii)

15 to 17 July 2025 have been designated as Home-Based Learning (HBL) Days for Secondary 1 to 3 students, while Secondary 4 and 5 students will be sitting for their GCE 'N' and 'O' Level oral examinations. During this period, Sec 1–3 students will be assigned online learning tasks to ensure curriculum continuity. We seek your support in encouraging and monitoring your child's/ward's active engagement in their learning on these days. Please note that there will be no additional HBL days scheduled for Semester 2.

#### 3. Temperature Taking exercise

At the start of every term, there will be a temperature-taking exercise. For term 3, it will be on 9 July 2025. Kindly ensure that your child/ward brings along a working oral digital thermometer to school for the exercise. In our effort to build a caring community, every Gessian needs to demonstrate social responsibility.

4. Secondary 4 Normal (Academic) Achievers' Programme (AP), Secondary 4 Express / 5 Normal (Academic) Afternoon Study Programme (ASP), and Timed Practice (TP)

To support our graduating cohort in preparing for the national examinations, the school will be conducting the following programmes in Semester 2, starting Tuesday, 8 July 2025:

#### i) Achievers' Programme (AP) – For Secondary 4 Normal (Academic) Students

During the AP sessions, subject teachers will conduct topical remedial lessons for selected students of 4NA. These sessions aim to strengthen their understanding of key concepts and improve their skills through targeted practice questions.

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#### ii) Afternoon Study Programme (ASP) – For Secondary 4NT, 4NA, 4Exp / 5NA Students

Subject teachers will be present to provide consultation sessions for students wishing to clarify their doubts. The ASP would be made compulsory for a group of identified students who have been informed by their teachers.
