Section C [25] Candidates respond to a variety of questions based on Text 4, a non-narrative text, and write an 80-word response to a summary writing task.	
	3	Appx 1 hour	PAPER THREE [30] Listening Section A [22] Candidates respond to a variety of listening tasks based on a number of audio recordings, which candidates will hear twice. Section B [8] Candidates listen to an informational text and do a simple note-taking exercise. Candidates will hear the recording only once.	
	4	Appx 20 min	PAPER FOUR [30] - 20% Oral Communication The two parts in this paper are thematically linked. Part 1: Planned Response [15] Candidates plan and deliver a response to a video clip and accompanying prompt presented on a computer screen. Part 2: Spoken Interaction [15] Candidates engage in a discussion with the Examiners on a topic based on the same video clip.
