### Did You Know?

Both Dunman High School and Anglo-Chinese School (Independent) were amongst the first schools selected by MOE in 1982 and 1983 respectively to offer the MEP to musically talented students.

From 2016, these two MEP schools have begun offering the Programme to external secondary students of both genders. Musically talented students in non-MEP schools can now apply to offer MEP as a subject at Anglo-Chinese School (Independent) and Dunman High School from Secondary One. These weekly 2-hour MEP lessons will take place in the afternoon.

#### What Do We Offer?

The MEP engages students in the musical activities of Listening, Composing and Performing, and provides opportunities for individual musical inclinations. Students will be challenged to sharpen their musical perception, broaden musical knowledge and create music, both individually and in groups. Students will also develop an appreciation of the cultural diversity in music.

In addition, students will:

- be part of a larger MEP community, comprising more than 750 like-minded musicians;
- interact with other MEP students through combined workshops, camps and other events;
- have opportunities to put up performances in schools and at national platforms;
- engage in authentic learning experiences at local and overseas learning journeys, concerts and through interaction with industry practitioners.

#### **Our Facilities**

Facilities enjoyed by MEP students at the two centres include:

- · Practice rooms and recording facilities;
- · In-house performance venues;
- Specialised Music IT Labs equipped with computers, music creating software such as Sibelius and Cubase, and music keyboards;
- Multimedia music resources, scores and books.
