STEM	 have a passion for Mathematics or Science, have an inquiring mind, and be able to work well in a team; have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6; and demonstrate creative ways in problem-solving. Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the trial and an interview. The session consists of: a STEM assessment; and an interview. Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer. 			



Basketball (Boys)		
	Male applicants should:	
Sports	 have a passion for Basketball and be able to work well in a team; and have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6. Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the trial and an interview. The session consists of: a general physical ability test; a talent-specific test; and an interview. Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer. 	



Football (Boys)				
Male applicants should:				
Sports	 have a passion for Football and be able to work well in a team; and have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6. Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the trial and an interview. The session consists of: a general physical ability test; a talent-specific test; and an interview. Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer. 			



Table Tennis (Girls)		
	Female applicants should:	
Sports	 have a passion for Table Tennis and be able to work well in a team; and have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6. Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the trial and an interview. The session consists of: a general physical ability test; a talent-specific test; and an interview. Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer. 	



Choir		
	Applicants should:	
Performing Arts	 have a passion for singing/music and be able to work well in a team; have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6; and enjoy singing as part of an ensemble. Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the audition and an interview. The session consists of: a solo vocal performance; a talent-specific test; and an interview. Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer. 	



Modern Dance			
	Applicants should:		
Performing Arts	 have a passion for dance and be able to work well in a team; have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6; and exhibit a passion for dance and is able to express creativity in dance routines. Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the audition and an interview. The session consists of: a solo dance performance; a performance reproduced based on a dance sequence provided; and an interview. Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer. 		



English Drama		
	Applicants should:	
Performing Arts	 have a passion for drama productions and acting, and be able to work well in a team; and have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6. Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the audition and an interview. The session consists of: a solo performance; a dramatic delivery based on a short monologue provided; and an interview. 	
	Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer.	



Marching band		
	Applicants should:	
Performing Arts	 have a passion for music and playing in an ensemble, and be able to work well in a team; and have obtained a Conduct Grade of 'Very Good' or better in Primary 5 and 6. Only short-listed applicants will be invited to the school for the audition and an interview. The session consists of: a solo performance on relevant band instruments; a ural tests and playing of scales; and an interview. Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee that the student will be shortlisted / given an offer.


