GESS will also be carrying out an extensive marketing campaign by printing brochures to showcase about the school's long history, distinctive programs and achievements. These will be sent to every P6 students of the 12 schools. They will send some to PTA as well. Ms Tan informed that next year Sec 1 intake will likely remain at 421. The school management also studied/analyzed the trends over the years and there seem to be slight drop in the intake for express stream compared to normal stream. Thus GESS had hence started their planning during the CB period to prepare for the open house 2020.
