	PAPER TWO [50] - 35% Comprehension Section A [5] Candidates respond to a variety of questions based on Texts 1 and 2, one of which will include visuals. Section B [20] Candidates respond to a variety of questions based on Text 3, which is narrative in nature. Section C [25] Candidates respond to a variety of questions based on Text 4, a non-narrative text, and write an 80-word response to a summary writing task.		1 h 50 min
	PAPER THREE [30] - 10% Listening Section A [22] Candidates respond to a variety of listening tasks based on a number of audio recordings, which candidates will hear twice. Section B [8] Candidates listen to an informational text and do a simple note-taking exercise. Candidates will hear the recording only once.		45 min
	PAPER FOUR [30] - 20% Part 1: Planned Response [15] Candidates plan and deliver a response to a video clip and accompanying prompt presented on a computer screen. Part 2: Spoken Interaction [15] Candidates engage in a discussion with the Examiners based on the same video clip		20 min (including 10 min of preparation time)
Mathematics	Paper 1: [50 Marks] Calculator is not allowed. Candidates are to answer ALL questions. About 14-16 short answer and structured questions carrying 2 – 4 marks each. To include 4 – 6 marks questions assessing the mathematical processes of reasoning, communication, connections, modelling and higher order thinking skills in Paper 1. Weighting: 50% Paper 2: [50 Marks] Calculator is allowed. Candidates are to answer ALL questions. About 7-8 structured and long answer questions carrying 4 – 8 marks each. To include a problem in real-world context as the last question. Such a problem contains authentic information where students have to extract the relevant mathematics, formulate the problem mathematically, solve it and interpret the solution in the context of the problem.
